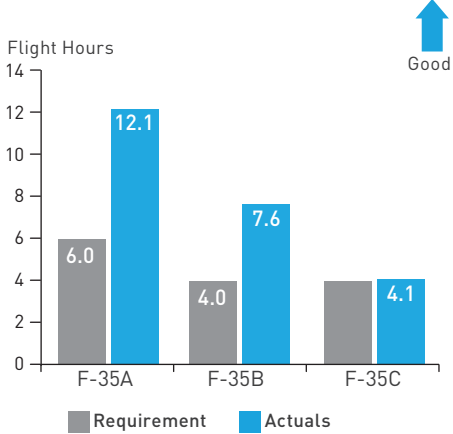

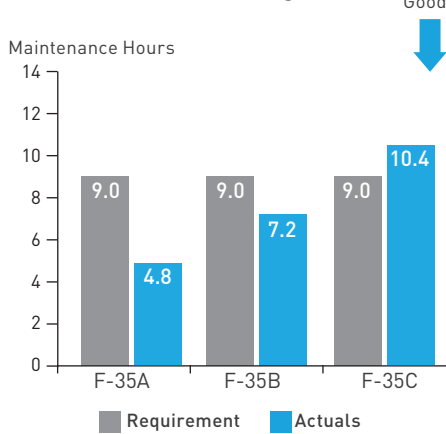
- U.S. Air Force F-35As deploy to the U.S. Central Command area of responsibility. [July 26](#)

**Reliability: Mean Flight Hour Between Failure**

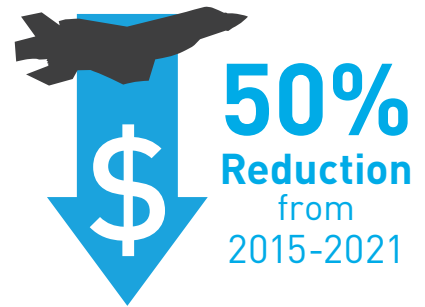


**Maintainability: Maintenance Man Hour Per Flight Hour**



**F-35 Affordability**

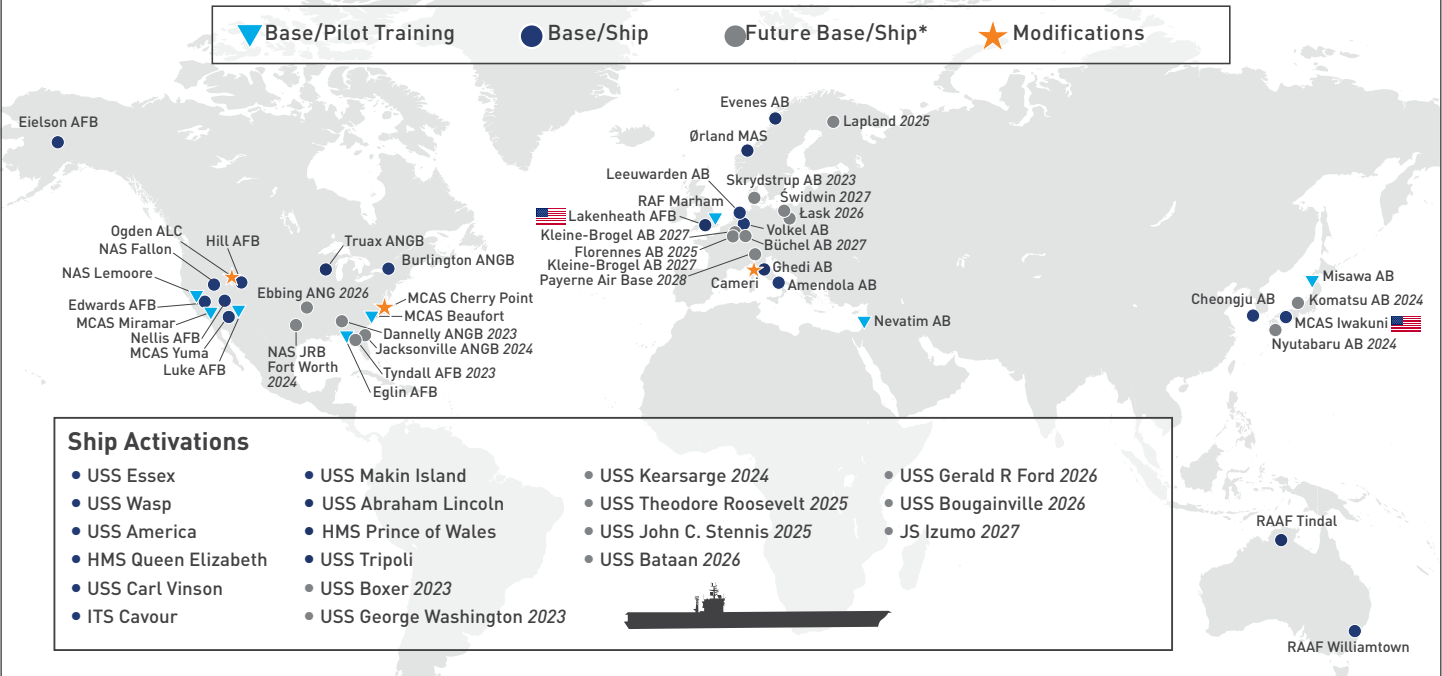
**Cost Per Flight Hour\***
